

ORDER

NOW, November 19, 2019, upon consideration of the Unopposed Application for Extension of Case Management Deadlines requesting that the Court enter the following order, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the case management deadlines are extended as follows:

1. All fact discovery shall be completed by February 3, 2020.
2. Primary expert reports shall be served by March 2, 2020.
3. Rebuttal expert reports shall be served by April 1, 2020.
4. Motions for summary judgment and briefs in support thereof shall be filed by June 1, 2020. Responses to motions for summary judgment and briefs in opposition thereto shall be filed by July 1, 2020. Any reply briefs shall be filed by July 15, 2020.
5. Following disposition of any motions for summary judgment, the Court shall, if necessary, schedule a pretrial conference.
6. Trial is tentatively scheduled for the fall of 2020.
