## <u>O R D E R</u>

**NOW**, June 22, 2021, following the pretrial conference, the Court enters the following order:

Trial in this matter is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on September 9,
2021, in Courtroom 3002 of the Pennsylvania Judicial Center, Harrisburg.
Petitioners shall secure a court stenographer.

2. The parties indicated that they have reached a consensus on a variety of trial-related topics and continue to meet and confer to resolve any remaining issues. By August 13, 2021, the parties shall file a status report indicating what topics have been resolved and the terms of that agreement, as well as identify any topics may require court intervention. Therein, the parties shall also indicate how much time is being requested by each party for opening statements. A final pretrial conference to discuss remaining issues shall be held at 1:30 p.m. on August 17, 2021, in Courtroom 3002 of the Pennsylvania Judicial Center, Harrisburg.

3. No later than July 26, 2021, the parties shall indicate to the Court whether they have reached a stipulation as to the authenticity and admissibility of documents produced by the Pennsylvania Department of Education during discovery.

4. Respondents shall serve and file a list of exhibits intended to be offered at trial no later than July 21, 2021. Any motions *in limine* related to the Respondents' proposed exhibit lists shall be filed no later than August 4, 2021, and any responses thereto shall be filed no later than August 11, 2021. All other deadlines in the Court's April 1, 2021 Order not inconsistent with this Order shall remain in full force and effect.

5. No later than August 10, 2021, the parties shall file a stipulation of facts.
