Request for Act 1 Graduation Support Retroactive School Year 2021-2022

Dear _____ (Principal, Solicitor, and/or Superintendent),

I am writing to notify you that _____ (student's first name) is eligible for support under Act 1 of 2022,¹ which requires schools to ensure equitable access to school and timely graduation for students K-12 who have experienced "education instability" due to homelessness, foster care, involvement in the delinquency system, or court-ordered placement.

_____ (student's first name) last attended _____ (school) in _____ (school district) during the 2021-2022 school year. Under Act 1, this student was entitled to receive a Point of Contact and other support to assist them to graduate.

A Point of Contact has already been assigned to work with this student. I request that _____ (Point of Contact's name) work with _____ (student's first name) to identify a pathway to graduation, which will be retroactive to the 2021-2022 school year.

A Point of Contact HAS NOT has been assigned to this student. Therefore, I request that a Point of Contact be assigned. This person should work with this student to identify a pathway to graduation retroactive to the 2021-2022 school year.

Not Yet Recognized as Eligible: The school failed to recognize this student as eligible for the protections of Act 1 during the 2021-2022 school year. I am able to confirm that _____ (student's first name) is eligible and ask that a Point of Contact be assigned immediately to work with this student to identify a pathway to graduation retroactive to the 2021-2022 school year.

As you know, the Act 1 Point of Contact must *create a student-specific individualized Graduation Plan* to ensure on-time graduation. **Act 1 permits eligible students who attended school during the 2021-2022 school year but were not afforded a pathway to timely graduation to be graduated during the 2022-2023 school year without attending school or completing additional requirements.** In such cases, a student’s diploma should be retroactively dated to the 2021-2022 school year. Schools are encouraged to exercise flexibility as to how credits are recognized to support students’ ability to graduate on time, in accordance with Pennsylvania Department of Education’s [Act 1 guidance](#).

In determining a pathway to on-time graduation, *the Point of Contact must follow the following process to determine how a student may be able to graduate:*

- **School Last Attended During the 2021-2022 School Year:** The Point of Contact must first determine if a student qualifies to graduate from the school they last attended after considering all full and partial credits earned in prior schools and options for a student to demonstrate proficiency in coursework. If possible, the student should be graduated from this school.
- **Prior School:** If graduating from the school they last attended is not possible, the Point of Contact can request a diploma from a school the student previously attended if the student meets that school’s graduation requirements.
- **State-issued Keystone Diploma:** As a last resort, if a student cannot graduate from the school they last attended or a previous school and the student meets statewide graduation requirements under Act 158, the Point of Contact should support the student in applying for a state-issued Keystone Diploma.

Because this student was denied a pathway to on-time graduation last year as required by Act 1, I hereby request that _____ (student’s first name) be immediately afforded a pathway to graduation and that the school’s Act 1 Point of Contact reach out to me to facilitate connecting with this student.
